



Greetings from Parks Ski Team:

Parks and Sunburst are very excited to host the **night** race on February 27, 2010.

Please make sure that your entire family is dressed for whatever weather we may have! Here is some information from Sunburst that will help all of us have an enjoyable race experience.

Parking

Parking will be on availability. Car pooling is strongly recommended. Parking in the normal ski area lots is recommended. Please do not block driveways. The Town of Kewaskum has restricted parking on the road and has been ticketing violations.

Lodge

Sunburst is requesting that racers use the yurt (round brown tent) and the white tent next to the Yurt, to change and store their gear (ski/boot bags, coolers, etc) for the day. The yurt will be available starting at 4:00. ***The yurt and tent are both heated*** to a very comfortable temperature and has sufficient storage racks for your gear. Please remember to deposit all your trash and recyclables in the appropriate containers. Ski/boot bags will not be allowed in the bar area of the lodge. Brown bag lunches are also not allowed in the bar area. **PLEASE NOTE: Sunburst's liquor license does not allow carry in alcoholic beverages anywhere on the property!**

The cafeteria in the lodge and new Beach House will be open for lunch, snacks and hot drinks. Additionally, the Snack Shack located on the patio will be open for lunch serving up grilled burgers and brats and all the fixings. The bar area also has a limited sandwich and pizza menu available.

Lift Tickets

Lift tickets can be purchased at the regular Sunburst ticket windows and in the Beach House beginning at **3:30 pm**. Ticket prices for this night race only have been reduced as follows \$18.00 for 5-6 racers, \$26.00 for 1-4 racers and adults. Identify yourself as part of the WJR race group to get your discounted lift ticket price.

Race Details

Inspection of the first course begins at 4:00 PM with the race starting at 4:30 PM.

As in the past, J5-6 will be racing on Exhibition; J1-4 will be racing on Bull Run.

Race workers, including gatekeepers, should report to the finish area of their respective course at 3:45 PM so that the Chief of Race can insure that all jobs are covered. We will make a general announcement at that time for the workers to report to the finish area.

Awards Presentation

The awards presentations will be held in the white tent or around the fire pit as the weather permits. Awards will be presented as soon as possible following the conclusion of the race.
